

The Cochin Club

Club Rules

1914/1915
Amended 2013

1. That the object of this Club be to advance and encourage the culture of Cochin of all colours and to use every endeavour to suppress fraudulent exhibiting of birds of this breed.
2. That the affairs of the Club be conducted by a President, Vice-Presidents, Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Secretary and that these constitute a committee to watch over the general business of the Club.
3. That all Officers be elected annually at the General Meeting to be held at the Club Show.
4. That the Secretary has no power to make any payments without the sanction of 2 members of the Committee and that he shall send a yearly balance sheet duly audited to all members of the Club.
5. That the terms of membership be an annual subscription of £10 payable by each member and that the financial year ends with the Annual General Meeting at the Club show. Subscriptions for the ensuing year become due on that date.
6. That no member be entitled to compete for any of the Club specials if their subscription be in arrear at the time of entry.
7. That at the Annual General Meeting it will be competent for any member to propose any alteration in, or addition to, these Rules and Regulations subject to giving 15 days notice thereof to the Secretary in writing.
8. That the Committee have power to arrange for meetings of the Club to be held at any of the principal shows throughout the Kingdom.
9. That the records be made and preserved of the Club's transactions and suitable reports from time to time forwarded to the newspapers by the Secretary.
10. That any member who is found guilty of fraudulent practices by the committee or Poultry Club shall cease to be a member and shall forfeit all rights as such.
11. The Club is to comply with current Data Protection Regulations
